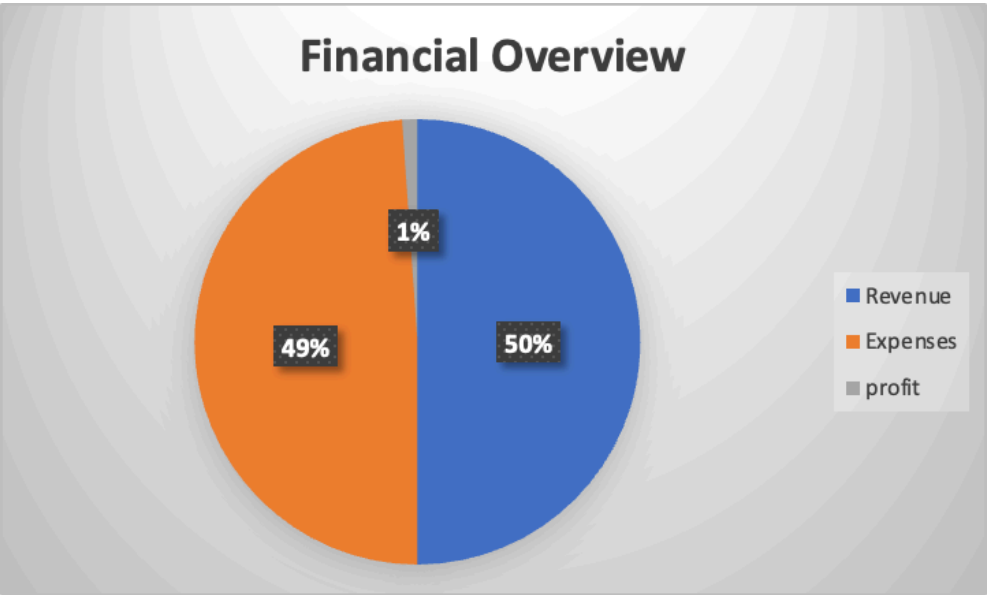
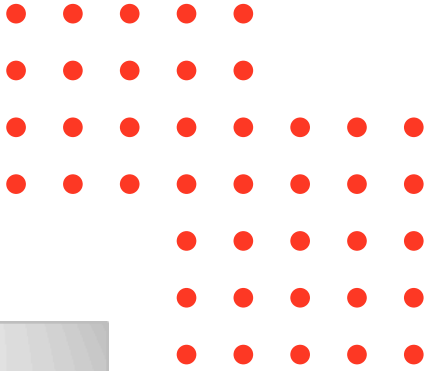

#### ***Program Expansion***

This year, we expanded our impact with several key initiatives:

- **LiveWell YAP Launch:** Introduced a new program focused on youth wellness, leadership, and personal growth.
- **Young Excellence Club Events:** Successfully hosted our inaugural Mother's Day Tea, bringing together over 160 community members and honoring 10 outstanding mothers.
- **Scholarship Excellence Cohort:** Achieved a 100% college acceptance rate for the Class of 2025, with students gaining admission to top universities nationwide.
